- Meets – exhibits mastery of grade level expectations
- Developing – working toward grade level expectations with direct guidance

The scale below is used for unified arts:

- Shows strong interest
- Participates

The scale below is used for the responsibility for learning and social development section:

- Consistently exhibits appropriate skill/behavior
- Sometimes exhibits appropriate skill/behavior
- Seldom exhibits appropriate skill/behavior

2nd Grade
